Learning at Longhoughton CE Primary School

We learn through lots of different subjects at Longhoughton C of E Primary School including:

Maths— In Maths we learn about addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. We sometimes learn about measures and shapes. We learn out times tables and how to tell the time.

We do a CLIC session 3 times a week:

- Counting
- Learn Its
- Its Nothing knew
- Calculations

English— In English we learn our sounds through Read Write Inc and develop our punctuation and grammar through Basic Skills (KS2). We read and write stories, information texts, reports, instructions and poems.

Computing – In computing we learn about E-Safety, Bee Bots, coding and lots more. We have laptops and iPads to help us learn.

RE – In RE we learn about Christianity and other world religions – Judaism, Hinduism and Islam. We do a Christmas play every December. Sometimes we read our Bibles.

Science—In Science we learning about plants and animals, light and sound and forces. We carry our investigations to see if our ideas work

The older children are Buddies. They look after people if they are hurt at playtime, they play games and help out in the dinner hall.

Head Boy and Head Girl

When you are Head Boy and Head Girl you give the registers out at lunchtime.

On Thursday's they collect the castle points in and count them ready for Wall of Fame.

On a Friday you help Mrs Critchlow by reading out the certificates, giving out badges, changing the castle point display and putting up the certificates on the Wall of Fame board.

<u>Jobs</u>

We all work as a team at school and each has class has jobs that we do:

- Register—taking the register to the office
- Milk—collecting the milk from the fridge each day
- Fruit—collecting the fruit each day

Year 4/5 children have some additional jobs to do around school:

- Doors—holding the doors open at worship time
- Music—playing the music in worship
- Pet patrol—looking after the school guinea pigs

French— In KS2 we do French through stories like Goldilocks and the 3 Bears and The 3 Little Pigs. We also learn about the French names for colours, body parts, numbers, classroom resources,

Food Technology (Cooking) – We cook in America Classroom. In cooking we bake lots of different recipes – cookies, gingerbread to name a few. We cook foods linked to our class countries –

We have an annual Bake Off each year and there is the Let's Get Cooking Club after school.

Art and Design – In Art we do painting, sketching, collage, drawing and design work.
