## Reading and Spelling Workshop

Thank you to the parents who attended the Reading and Spelling Workshop at the end of November. Information from the presentation has been added to the school website. If you click on 'The Curriculum' link at the top of the website and then click on 'Our School Curriculum' on the left hand side and scroll down you will find several attachments:

- Read Write Inc Speed Sounds
- VIPERS sheets for KS1 & KS2 these pages give ideas or questions that can be asked during reading time to support reading comprehension (the children do have these in the front of their reading records)
- Activities for practising spellings we have created a selection of activities that the KS2 children could use to help them learn their spellings across the course of the week. Y5 & Y6 have these in the front of their Homework Books and Y3 & Y4 have a laminated sheet in their book bags. We would like KS1 children to continue to complete the spelling sheet that they have in their Homework Folders 1 column a night for 4 nights but they might like to try some of the activities on the website in addition.
