# World Maths Day – Wednesday 6<sup>th</sup> March

On World Maths Day we will be giving the morning over to maths. We will be planning a series of maths problems and activities for the children to tackle. As you will be aware the children from Y2 to Y6 have started Rock Star Times Tables. The children all have their own logins for use at home and the children seem to be taking to this very enthusiastically.
