Reading at Home

Some children are still not bringing their Reading Record to school or getting it signed by an adult on a regular basis. Please continue to read with your child at home at least three times a week but ideally every night as part of their daily routine and homework.

Spellings

Depending on the group they are in for Basic Skills, some children will continue to bring spellings home to learn each week. Please ensure they learn these each night rather than leaving it till the night before their spelling test.

Homework

The homework this term is a project on The Maya. Your child should have brought home the project home at the end of last half term. The project is due in on Monday 26^{th} November. Please do not bring any work in before this as we do not have room to store it in school. In addition to this, your child will have lines and songs to learn for the Christmas production.

P.E. /Swimming

UKS2 will continue swimming at Willowburn this term. If your child is in Melvin's group, they will need to bring a pair of pyjamas as well as their swimming kit. If your child did wall bouldering last term, they will be doing gymnastics this half term and vice versa. NUFC will continue to be on a Monday. Please ensure your child brings a full, outdoor P.E. kit as we will be outside as much as possible.

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Punctuality

As you may have noticed, the children have tasks to complete when they come into school. If your child is late they will miss vital learning to aid their spelling and vocabulary or any intervention sessions. Please ensure your child arrives on time and is ready to begin their learning

Snacks
