After School Sports Clubs

For the last couple of years we have used the Sports Premium money to pay for the coaches that run the after school sports clubs.

As the new financial year starts we have been allocated the funding for another year but are now looking to invest this money in larger PE equipment and have therefore made the decision to stop providing free Sports Clubs and once again charge for these activities, the coaches will be paid from these charges.

If children are using Acorns after the sports session then parents will only be charged one amount of £3.50. Please bear this in mind when completing the Summer Term Club letter that will be coming out soon.

Parking

As you may remember from the December Newsletter we wrote to you about parking outside school.

There have now been 2 meetings with the Parish Council, Wendy Pattison and a representative from Northumberland County Council Highways looking at issues surrounding parking on Lacey Street and Crowlea Road. The second meeting was a public meeting which some residents did attend. We have now been informed that the area at the bottom of Lacey Street, next to Lacey Court and in front of the cut through to the field is not actually a parking area; it is a turning circle. The Highways Department are looking to put up signage so we ask that parents do not park here in the future.

In addition one suggestion that has been made is for the Parish Council to consider introducing restrictions to vehicle access to the 2 named streets. Whilst this may not happen we would like to ask again that everyone continues to be considerate when parking near to school.

Please do not park across driveways so that local residents can still leave or gain access to their homes or on the grass verges. Please be aware that more drives are being created and used on Lacey Street so please keep a look out for these changes.
