## Primary School Sport Premium Development Plan 2017 – 18 (Impact)

This document will create a plan to help ensure that funds are targeted systematically to achieve maximum impact in school.

The plan will run for the academic year 2017/18 however funding will come from the financial years 2017/18 and 2018/19

In March 2017 the funding was based on £8,000 per school + £5 per pupil.

In September the DfE announced there would be a funding increase to £16,000 per school + £10 per head.

Although this plan was originally set for the academic year 2017/18 for reporting purposes the financial year 2017/18 will be used. The funding available for the financial year 2017/18 was  $\pounds$ 13,334

We will target funds and monitor impact by:

- enhancing the PE provision for children
- setting a new standard in children's activity levels
- meeting the inclusion requirements and the value for money criteria which will be set by Ofsted.
