World Maths Day – Wednesday 4th March

On World Maths Day we will be giving the morning over to maths. We will be planning a series of maths problems and activities for the children to tackle.



For World Maths Day we would like the children to come dressed as a rock star (fictional or real) – this could be any rock star type character or they may even like

to dress up as their Rock Star Times Table avatar. For a slightly easier option they could wears jeans, a top and sunglasses.

Although Nursery, Reception and Year 1 are not using Rock Star Times Tables they can still come to school dressed as a rock star – jeans, t-shirt, sunglasses, hat/cap, gel in their hair. You do not have to spend any money on this – just what they have in their wardrobe. Please remember dressing up is optional.



World Book Day – Thursday 5th March

For World Book Day this year we are going to spend the day sharing books and completing reading activities.

The children can come to school dressed as a book character, in their pyjamas or a onesie and bring their favourite book to school to share with other pupils.

During the day the classes will be looking at different stories from the '**Just So**' stories by **Rudyard Kipling** and then they will be completing art activities to decorate the classroom doors – please bear this in mind when planning the clothes the children will wear – we will have art aprons for the children to wear but paint can still be messy!

Please remember the children will still be playing outside during the day so they might want to wear a tshirt under their pyjamas and they will still need to wear their outdoor shoes.

We would also like the children to donate £1 of their pocket money to Book Aid International on World Book Day. There will be a cake stall at the end of the school day, with all proceeds going to Book Aid International.

Sport Relief – Friday 13th March

For Sport Relief the children will be taking part in a variety of sporting activities throughout the day. The children have had a letter outlining the sponsored run/walk and will hopefully be able to collect some sponsors for this. We are asking that the children come to school in their PE kit on that day so we do not need to get them changed for the different events. Parents are welcome to come along for the walk/run but please remember the terrain is not suitable for pushchairs/prams.
