Uniform and P.E. Kit

Our uniform consists of black/grey skirts or trousers, a navy school sweatshirt with a gold polo shirt. School uniform can be ordered on line through the school website or from the school office throughout the year.

P.E. kit should comprise of a T-shirt, shorts and trainers (not black soled) in a named drawstring bag. P.E. kit should remain in school during the week.

School Lunches and Snacks

Children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 are entitled to a free school meal. School lunches for Year 3, Year 4 and Year 5 children cost £2.20 each. Payment should be made in advance of the meal being taken. You can pay weekly, monthly, termly, whichever is best for you. Money should be sent in a named purse or envelope and placed in the money tray in the classroom. (Cheques payable to Northumberland County Council). The meals are cooked on the premises, if your child has any special dietary requirements please let us know.

We have a couple of children in school who have <u>severe nut allergies</u>. Please <u>do not</u> send any food or drink items, into school, that clearly contain any type of nut or that you think may contain any type of nut.

Some examples of these foods are:

- Peanut butter
- All chocolate spreads
- Nutty whole grain breads
- All kinder chocolate i.e. Hippos
- Some cereal bars

If your child is having a packed lunch, please ensure that it does not contain chocolate, sweets or a fizzy drink.

Your child can bring a snack into school for playtime. This is restricted to a cereal bar or fruit. Please no sweets, crisps or chocolate.















Absences and End of Day Routine

Please ensure that, if your child is absent from school, you phone or contact us by 9.15a.m. and let us know why they are unable to attend. If, at the end of the day, your child is to be collected by someone other than their parent please write down who they are going home with in the 'end of day book' in the classroom. If, during the school day, circumstances change please phone the office to let us know who is collecting your child.

Please do not allow your child to ride their bike/scooter in the school grounds.

Please note that dogs are not allowed in the school grounds.

If you are parking outside school please take care not to block driveways and avoid parking on the grass.
