If a place within Early Years at Longhoughton C of E Primary School is offered, the following conditions will apply:

- 1. There is no statutory right to a place. If places are oversubscribed the school will apply its own admissions criteria to determine which children to admit. If a child cannot be offered a place, there is no right of appeal against that decision.
- 2. Once allocated a place, that place will not be withdrawn until the child takes up a place in full-time education, or relinquishes that place. This right may be revoked by the Governing Body in exceptional circumstances.
- 3. The time for transfer to full-time education is at the beginning of the Autumn Term if the child is four by 31<sup>st</sup> August. In exceptional circumstances, transfer to Reception may be delayed to the beginning of the Spring Term by mutual agreement with the Head teacher.
- 4. Attendance in Early Years at Longhoughton C of E Primary School does not guarantee a place in Longhoughton C of E Primary School. Parents are to apply for school places in accordance with Northumberland County Council procedures.
- 5. Free 15-hour places are allocated as 5 x 3-hour morning sessions. It is expected that children will take up their full 15-hour entitlement with Early Years at Longhoughton C of E Primary School.
