The sponsored walk/run course was about 1/3 km long - here are the distances completed by each class:

St George Class - 149 laps = 47.9km

St Patrick Class - 248laps = 79.8km

St David Class - 311 laps = 100.1km

St Andrew - 361 laps = 116.2km

Total - 1069 laps = 344km - the distance from Longhoughton to Birmingham (give and take a little).
